Do you know who Pascal Giugliano was? No, well I will tell you, he was a sportswriter for the Courier Journal and at the end of the 1923 high school football season he picked the first All-State Football Team for the state of Kentucky. The team consisted of the very best varsity players from throughout the state. In terms of raw numbers those picked for the All-State team are thought to be in the top .001 percent in terms of football talent. In other words, they are better than 99.9% of all those playing in a certain year. In 1924 Earl Ruby along with eleven of the states most prominent high school football coaches took over the job of picking the All-State team. This tradition continues until today with the Courier Journal All-State team recognized as the most prestigious, in that now there are other entities that select their own All-State teams. In some years an offensive and a defensive team was picked. In some years there was a first team and a second team, and in still other years there were third teams and honorable mentions noted. To be one of those picked for the First Team is truly an honor and gives those select few an edge when advancing to the next level, that being the college football scene. During the Flaget years there were of course players who earned selections on the all-state teams. Those making the first team are known as some of the very best to have played at Flaget. The eighteen Flaget football stars that earned the honor of FIRST TEAM ALL-STATE by the Courier Journal are:
