THE RELIGIOUS TEACHERS OF FLAGET

This month we look at the status of the religious that taught at Flaget. In addition to the Xaverian Brothers, a number of Diocesan priests and nuns also taught. As the alumni population ages so do those who taught at the school. In the front of the room is a chart and book showing all of the religious who devoted time to the teaching of the Flaget student population. 135 brothers, 39 priests, and 5 nuns taught at Flaget during thirty-two year school existence. The vast majority of these teachers are now deceased.

I want to thank those who have donated the memorabilia that is on display in the museum. Recently several alumni have taken the time to drop items off at the museum.
