## ONE AND DONE

While this statement usually is used when referring to the present situation of college basketball players who go professional after one year of college play, it can aptly be applied to the Flaget girls basketball team. When Loretto High School closed its doors after the 1973 graduation a good number of the girls transferred to Flaget who would begin accepting girls for the 1973-74 school year. In order to accommodate the introduction of females to the Flaget campus certain physical changes were made. The changes included the addition of female sports programs. Track, tennis, volleyball, and basketball were offered now for the ladies. The girls teams would compete in the Academy League which was composed of the other Catholic girls schools in Louisville. The transition would not be difficult since Loretto had been a member of the Academy league since the early 1950s. Miss Hahn would be the head coach of the new Flaget womens basketball team and would guide them thru their one and only season. Nine girls were on the varsity team with most having played the season prior at Loretto.
